PAGB Masters of Print 2021

PAGB Inter-Federation Competition etc.

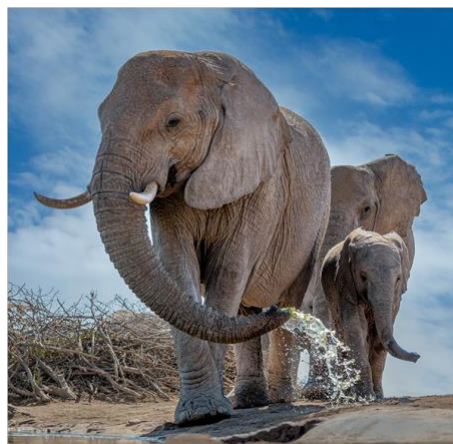
This year the competition was limited to just two categories, Open and Nature.

PAGB Awards for Photographic Merit

Print Adjudication

After many false starts the APM in prints went ahead on 26/27th June in Birmingham, much to the relief of the PAGB team and also some applicants who had been waiting for many months to have their work assessed.

From the published results, sadly entrants from our own Federation did not fare well. None of those who entered at Credit level were successful and we only had one achieve their Distinction. Congratulations to Philip Young of Basingstoke CC! Having been our Federation Awards Officer for so many years it is lovely to see someone who has tried before, not giving up and finally achieving their goal.

Looking at the stats, normally around two thirds of all the applicants are successful at Credit level - this time it was just on 40%. Conversely the percentage of those successful at Distinction level overall was 48% - higher than what is normally achieved.

November 2021 Adjudication: Newton Abbot

Bearing in mind the cautious note above, the PAGB are pressing ahead with plans that this will be the first "normal" adjudication since COVID, including, once again, Print sections. I am told there are still spaces available at all three levels in both PDI and Print.

I have already had a couple of people getting in touch - who were not successful last weekend - wishing to re-apply, which is a good sign.

The PAGB Awards Sec advised in early July that they still have quite a few spaces to fill for November. At the time of writing there were 27 spaces at Credit level and 30 spaces for Distinction. Now that we have a little more freedom this could well be the time to put together an entry.

Nature Images in SCPF Competitions

Following the lively discussion at the AGM on the proposed rules changes limiting the numbers of Nature images, our President Anne Eckersley invited clubs to share their thoughts and ideas for discussion at the June Council meeting. Thank you to all those who did. Having taken all these views into account the Council decided that the following will apply for the 2021/2 season:

There will be no restriction on the number of Nature images in the Leagues or the Exhibition. The League is an open competition. Nature images in these will continue to be judged, as with all other genres, as pictorial.

However in the Championships, where the winning clubs go on to represent the Federation in the PAGB championships, the Nature images submitted by any one club in either print or pdf format to four per section. This keeps the Championships in line with the PAGB rules governing their Championships. The PAGB nature definition will be used to determine what constitutes a nature image. The Council are continuing to look at the best way to manage this and more detail on this will be covered in the update to the Championships Rules later in the year.

There will continue to be no restrictions to nature images submitted to the Exhibition.

League News

With the continuing uncertainty in respect of the Covid pandemic, and to give certainty to clubs for their competition planning, it has been decided that there will not be a Print League in the 2021/2 season. The current Print League divisions will carry through to 2022/3, subject to any changes necessitated by new clubs joining etc.

Some clubs may wish to have a print competition with others, which the SCPF would be happy to facilitate if advised by clubs.

The deadline for entries to the PDI Leagues will be 30th September.

Facebook Group

Our Facebook page has now been discontinued, in favour of the Southern Counties Photographic Facebook Group. We would encourage clubs to sign up to the group; this will allow them to post freely details of any speakers, events etc, that they consider would be of interest to other clubs. We're keen to see it getting a lot more use, and hope it will become a valuable resource.

Contact Details and PAGB Handbook

The SCPF holds many pieces of information for over seventy clubs and their officers. In the coming weeks we will be ensuring that we have current details for your club's: secretary, competition secretaries, treasurer, and an email address for the SCPF representative (the member that attends SCPF reps' meetings) and anyone else in your club needing to receive SCPF emails such as this newsletter. Only the secretary's and competition secretary's details are made available in the directory – the remainder will only be used by Council. From next season clubs will be able, and actively encouraged, to maintain their own information for themselves.

It is in the club's interest to ensure that their details are up to date including a postal address. Recently, we were offered a short-notice opportunity for clubs to receive a free copy of the Masters of Print catalogue *only where we had address details – sadly, some clubs have missed out*. Hopefully, copies will be received soon.

PAGB handbooks for 2022/23 can't be collected at reps' meetings next season so will only be posted. This will be the last print edition with the intention that information will be only available online.

We are always looking for speakers. If you know of anyone in your club that can entertain a club for an evening with their photography or other photographic skills, please ask them to get in touch.
