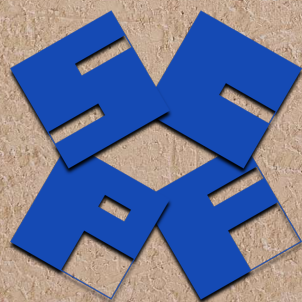

Your Federation has a huge number of very capable photographers so I really enjoyed seeing your work and experiencing such a variety of work.

Overall, the standard of the pictures was very good and, in particular, the nature images were excellent. I would appeal to the winners to enter their own Southampton International Exhibition because they are of international quality.

Some of the images had very muted tones that had been very well handled. A careful choice of papers was what gave many of the Print winners the edge. There were also some quite unusual images and I do like to encourage photographers who try something that little bit different.

Peter Gennard MFIAP EFIAP/d3

My interest in photography began when I was a teenager at the local youth club where I attended a photography group. I went along and was instantly hooked on the whole process of taking to printing the monochrome pictures.

After a few years I progressed to a local camera club and visited many local exhibitions, but a visit to Smethwick International Exhibition in 1983 marked a turning point. The quality of the photography from their members was overwhelming and if I was to improve my photography I needed to join that club. I joined the prestigious Smethwick Photographic Society and they encouraged me to enter FIAP approved international exhibitions. They also encouraged me to show my work to other photographic clubs and societies.

Part of the attraction of entering FIAP internationals is the thought that my work is good enough to be accepted alongside other photographers around the world.

FIAP (Federation International de l'Art Photographique) is an International Federation that supports international exhibitions by offering its Patronage. As encouragement to photographers to take part in international events FIAP created a world-wide system of photographic Distinctions, earned by success in their patronised exhibitions.

I achieved my AFIAP (Artist FIAP) in 1987 with 100 acceptances using 34 pictures that gained 10 awards. In 1991 I achieved my EFIAP (Excellence FIAP) with 353 acceptances using 72 pictures that gained 40 awards.

The pinnacle of my photographic career was gaining the highest FIAP distinction, MFIAP (Master Photographer FIAP) in 1993. I continued to build on my EFIAP distinctions by achieving the EFIAP/bronze in 1995 and the EFIAP/silver in 1996. The EFIAP/gold distinction was obtained in 1997 and the EFIAP/platinum in 2000. My latest distinction, the EFIAP/diamond 3 was obtained in 2022.

I still strive to get different pictures accepted in FIAP approved internationals. Once a picture has been accepted I don't send it to any other exhibition unless it is used to support Smethwick PS in competitions. To date, I have had 1382 different pieces of work accepted in slides, prints and projected images. They have gained 3850 acceptances; 38% of which were gained in 48 different countries. From those acceptances I have gained 558 awards.

Southern Counties Photographic Federation

The Southern Counties Photographic Federation (SCPF) is one of 15 Federations affiliated to the Photographic Alliance of Great Britain (PAGB), which in turn is affiliated to the International Federation of Photographic Art (FIAP). The federation currently has 67 member clubs and covers an area from Dorset to Sussex and from Berkshire to the Isle of Wight, Gibraltar and the Channel Islands.

The Council of the Federation serves member clubs in a variety of ways: organising inter-club competitive leagues with a Finals Day in May, annual Championships, an annual Exhibition, training and development for judges (for exhibitions and competitions), assistance with the attainment of PAGB awards and maintaining registers of judges and lecturers for use by member clubs.

What is a Club?

With the massive growth of photography on Social Media and some inevitable potential crossover with traditional clubs, the PAGB has had to clarify the definition of a "club" for PAGB administrative, competition and insurance purposes. Their definition is as follows:

"A camera club, photographic society, photographic club or photographic group with a published constitution and programme of events, united by a common interest in photography, meeting in person for mutual co-operation, education, entertainment or competition solely from one or more physical locations within the Geographical Limits of the PAGB.

"Only Clubs that fall within this definition can be insured, from renewal, under the PAGB agreed policies and only such Clubs will be able to compete in PAGB Competitions.

"Federations are autonomous and may, if they wish accept, as members, clubs not falling within this definition. They may permit them to participate in their Federation competitions. However, they may not use photographs from such clubs in PAGB competitions, including the Inter-federation competition."

The SCPF Print and PDI Championships are held in March each year. This is a one-day event and each year it is hosted by a different club from within our Federation. It is an inter-club event run under PAGB patronage and open to all member clubs. Clubs can enter up to fifteen images in either or both the Print and PDI classes. There are three judges who score all the images between two and five. All images compete for the individual gold medal winner and one of three "judge's choice" silver medals in each class.

The winning club and the runners-up in each class go on to represent the SCPF at that year's PAGB Inter-club Championships. The PDI event is usually held in July and the Prints in October.

Because of PAGB restrictions for their competitions, the rules for the SCPF Championships differ slightly from our other competitions with a restriction on the number of nature images that can be submitted. Full details of rules and how to upload images can be found on the Federation website.

Audio-visual sequences are a collection of images combined with a musical and/or spoken soundtrack. The SCPF Audio-visual Championship is a one-day event held in autumn each year. Each season it is hosted by a different club from within our Federation. A highly-respected judge from the AV community is chosen to appraise the work and attends to give comments and answer questions on the day.

This is an inter-club event and open to all member clubs. Clubs can enter up to three sequences of two to five minutes duration. After the scores are totalled certificates are given to the creators of the highest-scoring sequences and their clubs. The winning club receives the Oak Leaf Salver.

For members of our clubs that are challenged by the long distances involved in travelling to events, there is usually a re-showing of the sequences by Zoom.

SCPF Roll of Honour

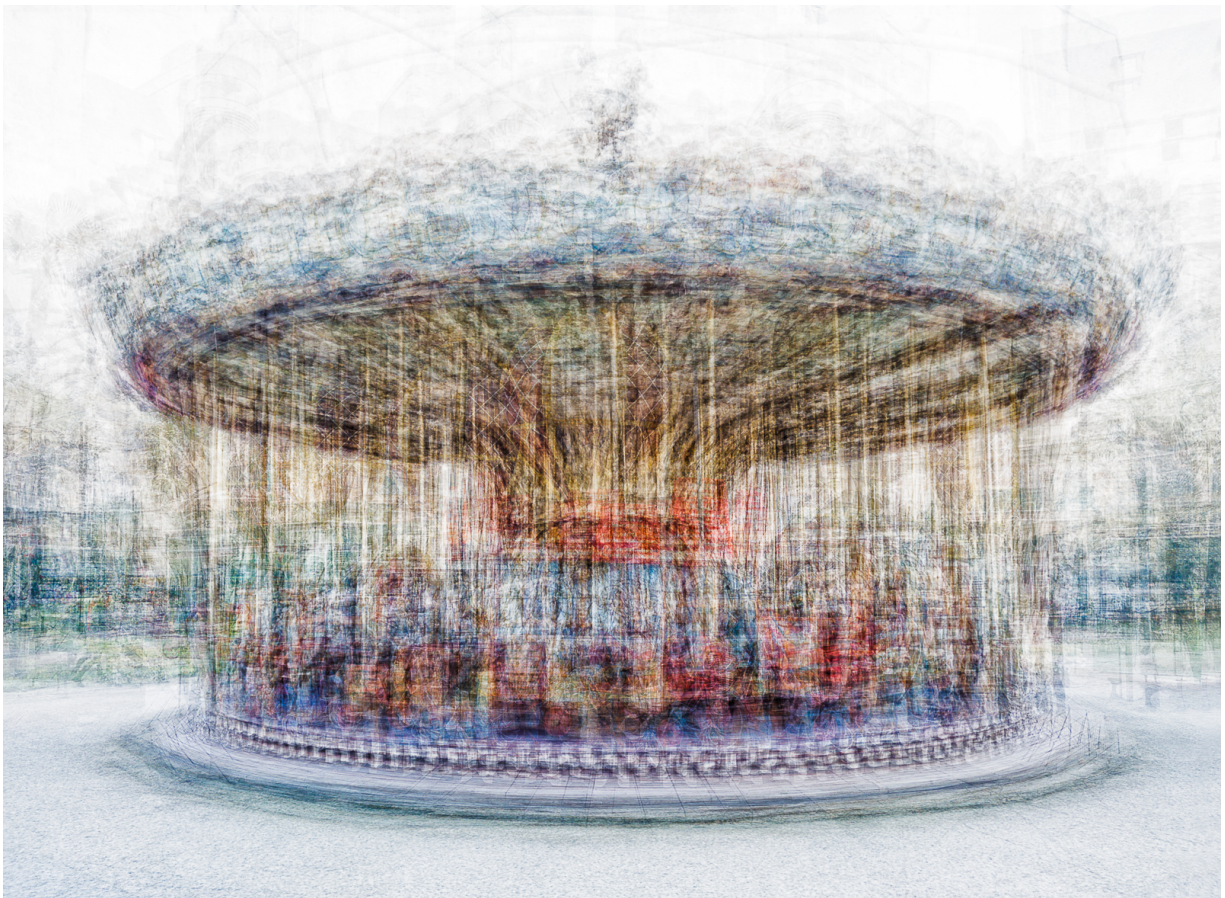
